A Deed from Mais-shil-govin-in-mi-gab to White Indians

Mannual Labor institute

Knows all men by these presents that J. Mais-shil-govin-in-mi-gab of Miami Indians of the County of Grant and State of Indiana in consideration of the sum of six thousand five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by White Indiana Mannal Labor Institute through its Trustees George Evans, Lottie Thomas, Aaron Hill, William Rees, Isaac Jay, Alfred Johnson, Jefe Wilson, David Miles, Jefe Small; and which institute was incorporated under an Act of the General Assembly of the state of Indiana approved January twenty seventh one thousand eight hundred & forty seven by articles of association made and concluded on the twenty fifth day of October A.D. 1852 and which are recorded in the Records office of the County of Wabash in the State of Indiana In Book J. pages 356, 357, 358, 359 the receipt of which sum of six thousand five hundred dollars is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant bargain sell and convey to the said White Indiana Mannal Labor Institute by & through the aforesaid Trustees & to their successors in office forever & for the sole and only purpose contained & set forth in the first of said articles of association hereinafter specifically mentioned, the following Real Estate in the County of Wabash and State of Indiana to wit a section of land to wit the "Dear Spick" alias Spa. Basin on the West side of the Wabash River nearly opposite the town of Wabash situated in Township twenty seven North seven East of the second principal meridian Indiana and which has been surveyed and designated as survey number twenty containing six hundred & forty acres of land according to the map of Indiana Grants surveyed and certified by the surveyor General on the 2nd day of September A.D. 1840 and being the same tract of land granted to the said Mais-shil-govin-in-mi-gab by the twelfth article of the Treaty between the United States of America and the Miami Tribe of Indians made and concluded at the forks of the Wabash in the State of Indiana on the sixth day of November A.D. 1838 together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging. To Have and to hold the same in fee simple to the said White Indiana Mannal Labor Institute and its Trustees for the purpose of establishing a Mannual Labor school in the County of Wabash and State of Indiana in conformity with a certain portion of the last will and Testament of Josiah White deceased late of Philadelphia in the state of Pennsylvania and which portion is substantially and particularly set forth in the aforesaid article first of said association. And to the said Trustees as such and their such successors in office forever, the Grantor his heirs and assigns hereby covenanting with the Grantee and the said
