Dear George:

As you know, the City of Richmond Unsafe Building Commission previously issued an Order requiring your client, My-Way Trading, Inc., to abate the public health and safety concerns at various properties under its control. Following the issuance of the Unsafe Building Commission Order, your client sought judicial review. The Wayne Circuit Court affirmed the Unsafe Building Commission's findings and conclusions.

With the above in mind, the City of Richmond is entitled to undertake the abatement efforts as My-Way-Trading, Inc. and/or Seth Smith have failed to pursue the same as required by the above-referenced Order. Additionally, the City of Richmond has acquired the subject properties through the tax sale process, and I suspect that the Board of Public Works and Safety will formally authorize the City to take title at its meeting on November 5, 2020.

With the above in mind, I wanted to provide your client with notice that he needs to immediately begin the process of vacating all of the sites that are subject to the Unsafe Building Order. This will allow the City to begin the process of remediating the health and safety violations that exist at the subject properties.
